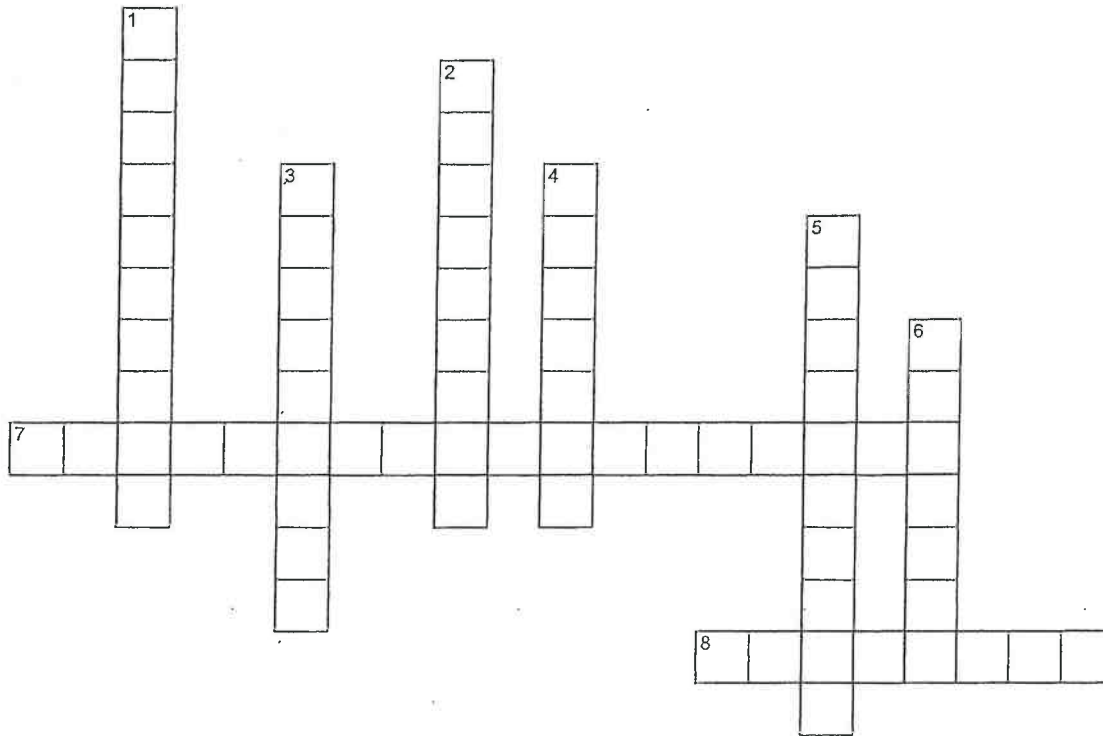

ACROSS

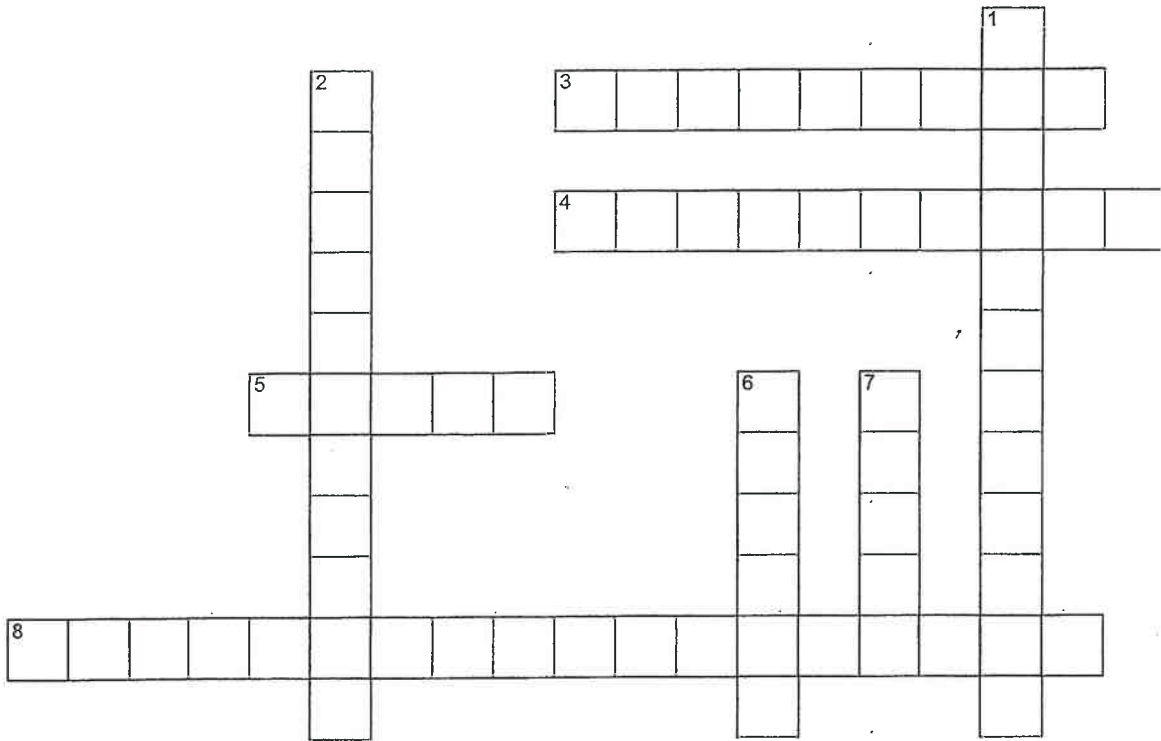
- 7 north, south, east, and west
